Subject: Examples of Objectives-through-Actions Sequences

After the meeting Wednesday on component refinement reports, it seemed that the refinement teams could benefit from some consistent terminology and examples of terms to consider for their efforts.

From the perspective of performing the EIR/EIS impact analysis beginning in February, it is essential that each component identify program-level actions that CALFED is proposing or considering for its preferred alternative. The program EIR/EIS needs to demonstrate which program-level actions are in the CALFED preferred alternative and why they are in it (and why others are not).

Attached for your consideration is a table showing **definitions of terms** in the Objectives-through-Actions Sequence drawn from previous CALFED documents where available. The table also shows **4 examples of using these terms**: one each from the four resource categories addressed by CALFED.

Also, for reference if useful, I've enclosed a copy of a memorandum we've prepared on "program decisionmaking in CALFED Phase II."

Please let me know if these materials might be useful for sharing with other CALFED staff or program team members.
