

At the meeting we propose to address points we have previously discussed, which need further clarification, and those that remain unresolved. Specifically we will focus on Delta water quality standards, CVP/SWP demands, CVPIA's 800,000 acre-feet for fish and wildlife, Mokelumne River flows, Sacramento River water contracts, DWRDSM assumptions concerning interior Delta barriers, drinking water regulations and agricultural subsidies. We will pass out an information package covering these items at the meeting.
