Dear Mr. Snow:

I would like to direct your attention to the long term water plan for the San Francisco Bay and Delta which is now being studied by the CALFED Agency.

Much study has gone into the three alternatives proposed by CALFED, but none of the alternatives have given enough weight to water efficiency or conservation in agricultural usage.

An acceptable CALFED program should include the following:

1- Restore waterways and protect watershed so fish and wildlife can be assured of a safe future.

2- Require water conservation programs that encourage efficient use of water -- especially in agriculture which uses the bulk of California water.

3- Before new dams, canals or reservoirs are built, all water should be used to the highest degree of efficiency.


