Dear Mr. Snow:

I urge CALFED to expand water efficiency, conservation, and reclamation programs to stretch our existing supplies instead of building new dams and canals.

I support CALFED's proposed restoration objectives for Central Valley stream flows, water temperature, stream meander, flood plain management, and riparian/riverine habitat as well as all sensitive, threatened and endangered species.

I oppose all CALFED alternatives that require construction of new or enlarged dams and canals, including the Peripheral Canal and an enlarged Shasta Dam.

I oppose CALFED's proposed restoration objectives for upper watershed forest management and delta hydraulics which increase logging and the building of more dams and diversions.


