


I am writing to oppose Calfed alternatives that require construction of new or enlarged dams and canals, including the Peripheral Canal and an enlarged Shasta dam. These proposed projects would cost billions of dollars and would be costly to the environment. Instead, I urge expansion of water efficiency and reclamation programs that stretch the existing water supplies.

I support your proposed restoration objectives for Central Valley stream flows, water temperature, stream meander, flood plain management, and riparian/riverine habitat. These objectives are needed to mitigate the impacts of current water facilities. However, I oppose your proposed restoration objectives for upper watershed forest management and delta hydraulics. Increased logging is not an environmentally sound solution to wildfire threat.


