Subject: McCormack Williamson Levee Profiles

Dear Board of Directors:

This is to inform you that, according to existing hydraulic models developed for the Beach/Stone Lake area, there are certain sections of your levee that are below the 100-year flood elevation. Raising these sections of levee can have an adverse impact to water surface elevations upstream. I have attached a plan sheet of the district showing where the hydraulic model shows sections of levee to be below the 100-year water surface elevation. I have also included a profile sheet of levee elevations.

The National Flood Insurance Program, administered by FEMA, requires the County to permit activities that increase water surface elevations. Any raising of the levee through these identified sections can have adverse impacts on upstream water surface elevations and a Floodplain Management Permit from Sacramento County will be required for any such work. If your records show that this reach of levee is higher than the information provided, please submit the information to our office so we can evaluate the new data.
