

Please refer to Page 149. Discussion of the “benefits-based approach” to addressing financial principles, with sharing of costs said to be the “cornerstone principle of the CALFED financial strategy” is fine in the most general sense. However, both with respect to allocation of financial requirements of implementation and actual allocation of water resources in the more direct sense, “equity” should not be allowed to circumvent the existing water right priority system in California, which has long established “fairness” with respect to water rights.
