Dear Director Snow,

Because I care about environmentally sustainable water use I am writing to urge you to create and select a fourth alternative to the peripheral canal draft plan which will provide ample high quality water for California's families, wildlife, farms and businesses.

None of the current alternatives put enough emphasis on conservation and restoration. The CalFed plan should include measures to:

- restore and protect our watersheds for high-quality, reliable water for people and wildlife
- ensure conservation programs and economic incentives to use our water more efficiently
- maximize water efficiency before even considering costly new dams, reservoirs and canals
- restore California's fish, birds, wetlands, rivers, delta and bays

Please select another plan with greater emphasis on conservation and restoration.


