I recently read an article by Congressman Wally Herger in the 5/13/98 issue of the Chester Progressive.


The article was new information to me regarding CALFED and its draft report for water plans for the expanding California population.

I strongly believe we need plans for new water storage. It is inefficient and a crime that we allow so much water to cause flood damage and to be wasted through excessive river flows to the ocean.


Do your plans meet California's water needs in 2020, 2030 and 2040?


