


It is my understanding that the three alternatives currently being studied by CalFed aim to conserve only 1% of the water used by agriculture. That is an absurdly low standard to set for a state that is going to need to be extremely abstemious in its use of water in the 21st century. Nor can it be argued that we don't know how to save large amounts of water and still run a profitable farm. Many farms in this country and abroad succeed on much smaller water allocations than the typical California farm uses. Please consider raising the water conservation target considerably in your Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Report and Statement.
