Dear Mr. Snow:

This letter is written as a follow up to our meeting Tuesday morning in your office with respect to the above-referenced matter. I am enclosing another copy of the McCloud River C.R.M.P. materials which we briefly reviewed during our meeting. As I indicated to you, the C.R.M.P. has gone on record unanimously in opposition to any heightening of the Shasta Dam which could in any way negatively effect the McCloud River. I understand from our meeting that you believe the Bureau of Reclamation may, if any action is taken, select the smallest height increment, i.e. 6 feet, as a possible increase for Shasta Dam which would still allow for the continued operation of the Marinas and other activities at Lake Shasta and would have little or no effect on the McCloud River. We trust that if any enlargement occurs, this will ultimately be the outcome. In the interim, we want to reiterate our opposition to any substantial increase in Shasta Dam height and request that we be kept advised as the matter is considered and moves forward. We sincerely appreciate your cooperation and look forward to working with you if this matter does, in fact, progress.


