The Pinole City Council believes that the issues discussed in the above-mentioned DEIS/EIR will greatly affect California's future water policy and the citizens of our community. At a special meeting held on June 28, 1998, the Pinole City Council reviewed the executive summary of Draft EIS/EIR (DEIS/EIR) for the CALFED Bay-Delta Program. At the hearing, the City Council took a formal action in opposition to Alternative 3 discussed in the DEIS/EIR and recommended that it be eliminated from further consideration in the revised DEIS/EIR, due to be released in December 1998.

The City Council also took action in support of the concerns about the CALFED Bay-Delta Program and the state's future water policy, outlined in the letter dated June 24, 1998, from U.S. Congressman George Miller's Office and signed by 16 other California legislators. This letter was sent to Bruce Babbitt, Secretary of the US Department of the Interior and Pete Wilson, Governor of California.
