Dear Mr. Beitenbach:

The Board of Directors of the Centerville Community Services District (CCSD) has reviewed and discussed the enclosed documents prepared by Shasta County in response to the Draft Programmatic EIS/EIR.

CCSD's Board unanimously supports the comments stated within the documents and requests that you submit a copy of your response to our office.

As with all agencies within the State, CCSD is extremely concerned about securing a reliable water supply for our community. During the past 15 years, we have been working towards that goal and have recently entered into an agreement to purchase a pre-1914 water right. We are currently negotiating with the Bureau of Reclamation to determine the amount of water available from the right.

One of the six solution principles adopted by the CALFED program which must be satisfied before any one of the three alternatives is acceptable is "focus on solving problems in all problem areas. Improvements for some problems will not be made without corresponding improvements for other problems." Our problem area has always been a reliable water supply. We are not sure how our problem could be improved by solving the reliable water supply problem for Southern California.

We wish you luck in your efforts in solving all of California's water problems in a fair and equitable manner.
