- ✓ **Acacia melanoxylon** Blackwood Acacia  
Tall fast growing tree reaching 30-50 ft. with a 20-30 ft. spread. White flowers noticeable Mar-May. Windbreak and biomass value.
- ✓ **Acacia redolens** Prostrate Acacia  
Fast growing drought resistant ground cover growing 2-3 ft. high and spreading 12-15 ft. Leaves are gray-green with yellow flowers Feb-April.
- Acer macrophyllum** Big-leaf Maple  
Large deciduous shade tree growing 30-90 ft. high. Native to moist streambanks and canyons. Noted for yellow fall color and resistance to oak root fungus.
- Acer negundo** Box Elder  
Deciduous fast growing tree, 40-60 ft. high, native to moist streambanks and valleys. Nice yellow fall color.
- ✓ **Achillea millefolium 'Rosea'** Rosey Yarrow  
Spreading perennial to 8-12 in. high with green fernlike leaves and rosey long stemmed flower clusters.
- ✓ **Achillea 'Paprika'** Red Yarrow  
Spreading perennial to 8-12 in. high with green fernlike leaves and long stemmed red flower clusters.
- ✓ **Achillea x 'Salmon Beauty'** Salmon Yarrow  
Spreading perennial to 8 in. high with green fernlike leaves and long stemmed, showy salmon/peach flower clusters.
- ✓ **Achillea tomentosa** Woolly Yarrow  
Spreading perennial to 6 in. high with deep green, hairy, fernlike leaves and yellow flower clusters.
- ✓ **Aesculus californica** California Buckeye  
Multistemmed shrub or small tree reaching 10-20 ft. tall and 10 ft. wide. Fragrant, white spring blooms are very showy, with leaves falling in summer to reveal a silvery bark.
- Alnus rhombifolia** White Alder  
Fast growing deciduous tree native to river and stream banks. 30-90 ft. height and up to 40 ft. spread.
- ✓ **Anisodonteia x hypomandarum**  
Miniature hardy hibiscus growing 4 ft. high with showy, long blooming, pink flowers spring through late summer.
- ✓ **Aquilegia formosa** Western Columbine  
Perennial for sun or shade areas growing 1 ft. tall and wide with red to yellow flowers that bloom April to September.
- ✓ **Arbutus menziesii** Madrone  
Evergreen tree or large shrub ranging from 30-60 ft. high. Noted for its showy reddish bark, pinkish spring flowers and red berries in fall.
- ✓ **Arbutus unedo** Strawberry Madrone  
Evergreen shrub or tree 10-25 ft. high with equal spread having white flowers and red fruit in fall and winter. Will develop interesting gnarled trunks with age.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos bakeri 'Louis Edmunds'** Manzanita  
Upright shrub 5-6 ft. tall with gray-green foliage and pink flowers in winter and spring.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos densiflora 'Howard McMinn'** Manzanita  
Dense, mounding shrub 4-6 ft. high and wide with pale pink flowers from late winter into spring.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos densiflora 'Sentinel'** Manzanita  
Upright growth habit which reaches 6-8 ft. high and 5-7 ft. wide, with pale pink flowers from winter to spring.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos 'Emerald Carpet'** Manzanita  
Low growing groundcover 10-18 in. high, spreading 3-6 ft. Dense, dark green leaves with pale pink flowers in spring. Will tolerate shade.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos hookeri 'Monterey Carpet'** Manzanita  
Compact, low growing variety 1 ft. high and up to 12 ft. wide. Dark green foliage and pink flowers in early spring. Tolerant of partial shade.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos hookeri 'Wayside'** Monterey Manzanita  
Mounding ground cover growing 2-3 ft. high and up to 12 ft. wide with pink flowers blooming Feb.-Mar. Tolerant of coastal and inland conditions.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos manzanita 'Dr. Hurd'** Common Manzanita  
Large shrub reaching 8-20 ft. high and wide. Dark red bark, large pale green leaves, and white to pink flower clusters from Feb.-Mar.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos 'Massachusetts'** Bearberry  
Small leaved, flat growing ground cover 8-10 ft. wide and 6-12 in. high with red winter color. Tolerant of snow and freezing conditions.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos 'Sunset'** Manzanita  
Mounding shrub 4-5 ft. high and 4-6 ft. wide. Has coppery red new growth later turning bright green. Pinkish-white flowers March-April.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Pacific Mist'** Manzanita  
Fast growing groundcover 2-3 ft. high and spreading 4-6 ft. Has gray-green leaves and pale pink flowers in winter.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Point Reyes'** Manzanita  
Low growing groundcover 1-2 ft. high with a 3-5 ft. spread. Has small leathery leaves, red stems and pink flowers in mid-winter.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Radiant'** Manzanita  
Low growing 6-8 in. high and 3-5 ft. wide. Noted for red stems, light green leaves, and light pink flowers followed by red berries in fall.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Woods Compact'** Manzanita  
Compact, dense leaves that turn bright red in winter. Grows 6-12 in. high and up to 8 ft. wide. Tolerant of snow and freezing conditions.
- ✓ **Arctostaphylos viscida** Manzanita  
Tough upright manzanita to 5 ft. high and 3-4 ft. wide with large, rounded, light green leaves and showy red bark.
- Aristolochia californica** California Dutchman's Pipe  
Deciduous vine needing shade and moisture having unusual shaped cream flowers with purple veins in winter-spring before green heart-shaped leaves appear.
- Ameria allicacea** Sea Pink  
Hardy evergreen perennial with bladelike foliage staying 4-6 in. high with pink round flower clusters rising above on naked stems to 8 in.
- ✓ **Artemisia californica 'Canyon Grey'** Canyon Grey Sagebrush  
Prostrate sage 3-4 ft. wide and 1 ft. high with finely cut silver foliage.
- ✓ **Artemisia arborescens 'Powis Castle'**  
Mounding shrub 3 ft. high and up to 5 ft. wide with fine silver foliage.
- ✓ **Artemisia pycnocephala 'David's Choice'** Sandhill Sage  
Compact perennial shrub growing 1 ft. high and spreading 2-3 ft. with silver feathery foliage. Tolerant of heavy clay and sandy soils.
- ✓ **Artemisia stelleriana 'Silver Brocade'** Seashore Artemisia  
A University of British Columbia Botanical Gardens registered introduction. Dense woody perennial which grows to 1 ft. high and has a prostrate growth habit. Leaves are feltly white and deeply lobed.
- ✓ **Atriplex lentiformis** Quail Bush  
Densely branched deciduous shrub with spines 3-9 ft. high and 6-12 ft. wide with gray-green leaves and yellow flowers in mid summer.
- ✓ **Atriplex lentiformis breweri** Brewer Saltbush  
Semi-deciduous shrub similar to *A. lentiformis* but has no spines on its branches. Adaptable and tolerant to many areas and conditions.
- ✓ **Baccharis pilularis consanguinea** Chaparral Broom  
Tough woody perennial with small light green foliage and profuse white flowers in fall that reseed readily. Grows 4-6 ft. high and wide.
- ✓ **Baccharis pilularis 'Twin Peaks II'** Coyote Brush  
Compact low growing shrub reaching 12-18 in. high with a 5-6 ft. spread. Dark leaves deeply toothed.
- ✓ **Baccharis viminea** Mule Fat  
Erect shrub growing 6-10 ft. tall with long, dark green foliage. Common in moist areas along waterways, yet also does well in drought conditions.
- ✓ **Berberis thunbergii 'Crimson Pygmy'** Pygmy Barberry  
Deciduous shrub with arching branches which reaches 1-2 ft. high and 2-3 ft. wide. Foliage becomes bronzy red in summer and fall.
- ✓ **Callistemon citrinus 'Jeffersii'** Bottlebrush  
Evergreen shrub to 6 ft. high and 4 ft. wide with showy reddish-purple flowers fading to lavender on stiff branches.
- ✓ **Calocedrus decurrens** Incense Cedar  
Evergreen trees reaching 75-100 ft. tall. Adaptable to many climates and tolerable of high summer temperatures and poor soils.
- ✓ **Calycanthus occidentalis** Spice Bush  
Deciduous shrub 6-12 ft. high. Takes sun to partial shade. Reddish brown flowers appear April-August, leaves have yellow fall color.
- ✓ **Carpenteria californica** Bush Anemone  
Dense, clean evergreen shrub growing 4-8 ft. high and 5 ft. wide. Tolerant of sun and shade. Has white fragrant flowers from May-August.
- ✓ **Carpenteria californica 'Elizabeth'** Bush Anemone  
A Saratoga Horticultural Foundation selection. Dense shrub with compact growth to 6 ft. tall with larger white flowers. Sun or light shade preferred. Hardy to 10°F.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Blue Jeans'** Wild Lilac  
Fast, vigorous shrub growing 6-8 ft. tall and wide. Tolerates heavy soil, drought, summer water, and has lavender flower clusters in spring.

- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Concha'**  
 Grows 6-8 ft. tall and wide. Has small narrow leaves with intense dark blue flower clusters in spring. Tolerant of coastal and inland conditions and summer watering.
- ✓ **Ceanothus cordulatus** Mountain Whitethorn  
 Evergreen shrub growing 2-5 ft. high with spiny stems, bluish-green leaves and white spring flowers.
- ✓ **Ceanothus cuneatus** Buckbrush  
 Upright shrub to 8 ft. with gray-green foliage and white flower clusters in spring.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Dark Star'**  
 Grows 5-6 ft. tall and 8-10 ft. wide. Has tiny dark green leaves with dark cobalt blue flowers in spring.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Frosty Blue'**  
 Grows 6-8 ft. tall and 8-10 ft. wide. Has small dense leaves with deep blue to white flower clusters in spring.
- ✓ **Ceanothus gloriosus** Pt. Reyes Ceanothus  
 Low ground cover ranging from 12-18 in. high to 6-12 ft. wide. Tolerates sun, shade, and cold climates. Serrated, dark green foliage with blue spring flowers.
- ✓ **Ceanothus gloriosus 'Anchor Bay'**  
 Low ground cover staying 12-18 in. high and 6-8 ft. wide with deeper blue flowers and denser foliage than *C. gloriosus*.
- ✓ **Ceanothus gloriosus exaltatus 'Emily Brown'**  
 A mounding shrub 2-3 ft. high and spreading 6-8 ft. wide with small, serrated foliage and dark blue flower clusters. Tolerates heavy soils and drought situations.
- ✓ **Ceanothus gloriosus var. porrectus**  
 Dense growth 2-3 ft. high and 6-8 ft. wide with small hollylike leaves and dark blue flowers. Needs shade in hot inland areas.
- ✓ **Ceanothus griseus 'Santa Ana'**  
 Large spreading shrub 6-8 ft. high and 10-15 ft. wide with small, dark green leaves and rich blue flowers. Tolerant of inland conditions.
- ✓ **Ceanothus griseus var. horizontalis** Carmel Creeper  
 Mounding shrub 2-3 ft. high and 5-15 ft. wide with glossy leaves and light blue flowers. Great for banks and mass plantings. Needs partial shade inland.
- ✓ **Ceanothus griseus var. horizontalis 'Yankee Point'**  
 Fast growing staying 3-5 ft. tall 6-8 ft. wide with large bright green leaves and blue flowers. Does well on the coast and in hot inland areas.
- ✓ **Ceanothus hearseiorum** Hearst Ceanothus  
 Very low grower; 6 in. tall and spreading 6-8 ft. wide. Dark green bumpy leaves and medium blue flowers.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter'**  
 Large shrub 2-4 ft. tall and spreading 6-8 ft. across with medium blue flowers in spike-like clusters in spring.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Julia Phelps'**  
 A medium size shrub 5-7 ft. high and 6-9 ft. wide with small dark green foliage and deep blue flower clusters on arching stems. Good tolerance to heat and drought.
- ✓ **Ceanothus maritimus** Maritime Ceanothus  
 Low growing shrub staying 1-3 ft. high and spreading up to 4-6 ft. Flowers generally light blue/lavender in spring. Takes full sun to part shade.
- ✓ **Ceanothus prostratus** Squaw Carpet  
 Prostrate growth spreading 6-8 ft. wide with leathery serrated light green leaves and flowers that are varied colors of blue. Does best at higher elevations.
- ✓ **Ceanothus 'Ray Hartman'**  
 Large shrub to small tree 8-15 ft. tall and 10-15 ft. wide with 2-3 in. dark green leaves and medium blue spring flower clusters.
- ✓ **Ceanothus rigidus 'Snowball'**  
 Rounded shrub 3-5 ft. tall and 4-8 ft. wide with small dark green leaves on stiff branches and white ball-like clusters of flowers in early spring.
- ✓ **Ceanothus thyrsoiflorus 'Skylark'** Blueblossom  
 Dark blue flower clusters bloom profusely on this 3-6 ft. tall shrub with a 5 ft. spread. Tolerates summer water.
- ✓ **Ceanothus thyrsoiflorus 'Snow Flurry'**  
 Large shrub reaching 6-10 ft. tall and wide with rich shiny green leaves and profuse white flower clusters in spring. Tolerates sun and partial shade.
- ✓ **Cercis occidentalis** Western Redbud  
 Deciduous large shrub ranging from 6-20 ft. tall and 10-15 ft. wide. Desirable for its magenta spring flowers, yellow to red fall color, and dangling winter seed pods. Tolerant of many soil types, drought conditions, and is resistant to oak root fungus.
- ✓ **Cheiranthus 'Bowles' Mauve'** Wallflower  
 Hardy, dome shaped mound to 3 ft. tall, with mauve/lavender flowers set off against blue-green foliage. Blooms in spring and again in fall.
- ✓ **Cistus corbariensis** White Rockrose  
 Mounding shrub 2-5 ft. high and wide with gray-green foliage and prolific white flowers in late spring and summer. Does well in harsh conditions.
- ✓ **Cistus purpureus** Orchid Rockrose  
 Mounding shrub 4 ft. high and wide with wrinkled foliage and purple flowers with a red spot at the base of each petal. Tolerates coastal, hot and arid conditions.
- ✓ **Cistus salvifolius 'Prostratus'** Sageleaf Rockrose  
 Spreading shrub 1-2 ft. high to 6 ft. wide with small gray-green leaves and white flowers with a yellow spot at the base of each petal. Good bank and ground cover.
- ✓ **Cistus skanbergii**  
 Compact shrub 1-2 ft. high and 3 ft. wide with soft gray-green leaves and small coral-pink flowers in spring.
- ✓ **Cistus 'Sunset'**  
 Low growing mounding shrub to 2 ft. high with soft gray-green foliage and bright rose colored flowers.
- ✓ **Cistus 'Wartley's Rock Rose'**  
 Dense low growing ground cover staying 1 ft. high and spreading to 3 ft. wide with dark green crinkled leaves and small rose-pink flowers.
- ✓ **Clematis amandii** Evergreen Clematis  
 Large vine reaching 20 ft. Noted for its fragrant, showy white flower clusters in spring and attractive dark green glossy foliage. Tolerates sun or part shade, moist soil, and prefers shade around roots.
- ✓ **Coleonema 'Pacific Gold'** Breath of Heaven  
 Fine textured, low growing shrub to 10" high and wide with bright yellow foliage. Excellent for rock gardens.
- ✓ **Coleonema pulchrum** Pink Breath of Heaven  
 Fine textured wispy shrub growing to 5 ft. with tiny pink flowers and fragrant leaves. Blooms sporadically through the year. Needs light soil and good drainage.
- ✓ **Convolvulus cneorum** Bush Morning Glory  
 Evergreen shrub 2-4 ft. high with silver foliage and white flowers from spring through fall. Prefers light soil, good drainage and full sun.
- ✓ **Coprosma kirkii**  
 Spreading evergreen shrub 1-3 ft. high and 2-5 ft. wide with small glossy leaves. Tolerates clay soils, mild drought situations, and wind.
- Comus nuttallii** Western Dogwood  
 Large deciduous shrub or tree reaching 50 ft. high and 20 ft. wide. Fall color ranges from yellow to red, and late winter flowers are white to pink. Prefers good drainage and infrequent summer watering.
- Cornus stolonifera** Redtwig Dogwood  
 Deciduous multistemmed shrub that gets 15 ft. high and spreads by underground stems. White summer flowers, brilliant red fall color, and red winter twigs. Tolerates shade.
- ✓ **Correa alba** Australian Fuchsia  
 Evergreen shrub to 4 ft. with arching branches and white flowers in summer. Needs good drainage and tolerates partial shade.
- ✓ **Correa pulchella 'Mission Bells'** Australian Fuchsia  
 Spreading evergreen shrub 2-3 ft. high and up to 7 ft. wide with deep pink to red winter flowers.
- ✓ **Corylus comuta** Western Hazelnut  
 Deciduous shrub with open spreading multistemmed growth habit from 5-10 ft. high.
- ✓ **Coloneaster dammeri 'Lowfast'** Bearberry Cotoneaster  
 Vigorous evergreen ground cover 1 ft. high and spreading by rooting branches up to 10-15 ft. Red berries appear in fall and winter.
- ✓ **Coloneaster horizontalis** Rock Cotoneaster  
 Flat, spreading, deciduous shrub growing 2-3 ft. high and to 15 ft. wide. Small leaves turn orange and red before falling off, and showy red berries cover the plant in winter.
- ✓ **Coloneaster microphyllus** Rockspray Cotoneaster  
 Evergreen shrub with upright branches 2-3 ft. high and trailing branches spreading 6 ft. Very tiny dark green foliage and red winter berries.
- ✓ **Dianthus alpinus**  
 Low growing perennial to 6 in. high with gray slender foliage and pink flowers from spring through fall. Spreads by rooting stems.

- Diascia 'Ruby Field'** Twinspur  
Low growing perennial 3 in. high and 6-12 in. wide with small foliage and pink 10 in. flower sprays April through November.
- Diascia vigilis** Twinspur  
Showy, hardy perennial growing 4-6 in. high and up to 12 in. wide with 12 in. pink flower spikes spring through fall.
- ✓ **Diplacus aurantiacus** Sticky Monkey Flower  
✦Drought tolerant evergreen shrub to 4 ft. with numerous yellow-orange flowers in spring and summer.
- ✓ **Eriogonum arborescens** Santa Cruz Island Buckwheat  
✦Loosely branched shrub growing 2-5 ft. high and wide with attractive shredding gray to reddish bark, gray-green leaves, and creamy pink flowers spring through fall.
- ✓ **Eriogonum crocatum** Saffron Buckwheat  
✦Compact, low growing perennial 1-2 ft. high and wide, having white woolly stems and leaves and contrasting yellow flower clusters summer-fall. Tolerates heavy soils if given good drainage and no summer water.
- ✓ **Eriogonum fasciculatum** California Buckwheat  
✦Evergreen shrub 1-4 ft. high with white hairy leaves and white flowers from spring to fall. Tolerates little to no water and is good for erosion control on slopes.
- ✓ **Eriogonum giganteum** St. Catherine's Lace  
✦Large open shrub growing 4-5 ft. high and 3-4 ft. wide with woolly, grey leaves and flat clusters of cream flowers that turn rust with age.
- ✓ **Eriogonum latifolium grande rubescens** Red Buckwheat  
✦Low growing woody perennial 1-2 ft. high and to 3 ft. wide. Showy dark pink summer flowers stand out against small gray-green foliage.
- ✓ **Eriogonum umbellatum polyanthum** Sulfur Buckwheat  
✦Low, woody perennial growing 1-2 ft. high with a 3-4 ft. spread, having dark green foliage and attractive yellow summer flowers.
- ✓ **Escallonia 'Red Elf'**  
Low growing evergreen shrub to 3 ft. with the glossy leaves of *E. rubra* and rosey-red flowers throughout the year.
- Fraxinus latifolia** Oregon Ash  
✦Deciduous trees reaching 50-80 ft. high. Grows well in areas where the tree is subjected to standing water during the winter.
- ✓ **Fremontodendron 'California Glory'** Flannel Bush  
✦Open and spreading evergreen shrub 10-20 ft. high with many yellow flowers blooming in spring. Plants need good drainage and little summer water.
- ✓ **Fremontodendron 'Pacific Sunset'** Flannel Bush  
✦Same as *F. California Glory* but has deep orange yellow flowers in spring and withstands garden conditions better.
- ✓ **Galvezia speciosa** Island Bush Snapdragon  
✦Evergreen shrub or vine 2-3 ft. high and 3-5 ft. across. Red flowers bloom through spring and summer. Give the plant partial shade in hot inland areas.
- Gardenia jasminoides 'Mystery'** Mystery Cape Jasmine  
Fragrant large white flowers in spring and summer adorn this 6-8 ft. high shrub. Plant in partial shade and give good drainage.
- Gardenia jasminoides 'Radicans'** Trailing Gardenia  
Low growing *Gardenia* staying 6-12 in. high and spreading 2-3 ft. with small leaves and 1 in. wide white fragrant flowers in summer. Good ground cover.
- Gardenia jasminoides 'Veitchii'**  
Prolific, fragrant white blooms cover this 3-4 ft. shrub from spring through fall. Good drainage is very important.
- ✓ **Garrya elliptica 'Evie'** Coast Silktassel  
✦Large shrub reaching 10 ft. with showy green tinged purple catkins in early spring. Good in sun or part shade areas.
- ✓ **Garrya elliptica 'James Roof'** Coast Silktassel  
✦Shrub to 4-8 ft. high or small tree to 20-30 ft. Wavy-edged leaves are 2-3 in. long, glossy on top and gray on the bottom. Has 8-12 in. long white showy flower tassels in winter.
- Gaufferia shallon** Salal  
✦Evergreen shrub bearing pinkish flowers in spring. Given full sun and poor, dry soil, it grows to 2 ft. Shaded plants in rich soil reach 4-10 ft.
- ✓ **Genista lydia**  
Low growing partially deciduous shrublet staying 2 ft. high with a spreading growth habit. Many yellow flowers appear in spring and summer.
- ✓ **Genista pilosa 'Vancouver Gold'**  
A University of British Columbia Botanical Gardens registered selection. Prostrate evergreen shrub 1 ft. high and spreading 3-5 ft. with golden-yellow flowers late spring to summer.
- ✓ **Grevillea 'Noellii'**  
Evergreen shrub 3-5 ft. high and spreading 4-6 ft. wide with needlelike foliage and showy pink and white flowers in spring. Tolerates poor soils.
- ✓ **Hebe 'Blue Elf'**  
Dense compact evergreen shrub growing 2-3 ft. with blue flower spikes in summer. Give full sun on coast and partial shade inland.
- ✓ **Helianthemum nummularium 'Apricot'** Sunrose  
Low growing evergreen shrublet staying 6-8 in. high and spreading 2-3 ft. with bright green foliage and apricot flowers that bloom from April-June. Full sun and hardy to 0°F.
- ✓ **Helianthemum nummularium 'Stoplite'** Sunrose  
Low growing evergreen shrublet staying 8-10 in. high and spreading 2-3 ft. with gray-green foliage and red flowers that bloom from April-June. Full sun and hardy to 0°F.
- ✓ **Helianthemum nummularium 'Wisley Pink'** Sunrose  
Low growing evergreen shrublet staying 6-8 in. high and spreading 2-3 ft. with light green foliage and pink flowers that bloom April-June. Full sun.
- ✓ **Heteromeles arbutifolia** Toyon  
✦Evergreen shrub 8-15 ft. high or small tree to 25 ft. Has leathery toothed leaves, white summer flowers, and clusters of red berries in winter. Tolerates sun or partial shade, heat, smog, wind, and heavy or light soils.
- ✓ **Heteromeles arbutifolia 'Yellow Berry'** Yellow Berry Toyon  
✦Same as above but with yellow berries.
- Hibiscus californica** California Hibiscus  
✦Erect stems grow 3-6 ft. tall coming from the base which gets just as wide. Hibiscus-like flowers are white/pink with crimson center. This plant is found on moist banks near waterways.
- ✓ **Iris douglasiana** Douglas Iris  
✦Evergreen perennial for sun or shade giving pale lavender to violet spring flowers.
- ✓ **Iris Pacific Coast Hybrids - mixed colors**  
✦Evergreen perennial for sun or shade. Hardy to 0°-10°F. Spring flowers ranging from purple, blue, maroon, yellow, and white.
- ✓ **Iris Pacific Coast Hybrids 'White'**
- ✓ **Iris Pacific Coast Hybrids 'Yellow'**
- ✓ **Juniperus c. procumbens 'Nana' Dwarf Japanese Garden Juniper**  
Low growing to 1 ft. and spreading 4-5 ft. with blue-green foliage. Needs little water and makes a good ground cover.
- ✓ **Juniperus conferta 'Blue Pacific'** Shore Juniper  
Prostrate low grower to 1 ft. by 6-8 ft. with needlelike blue-green foliage. Tolerates heat well.
- ✓ **Lavandula angustifolia** English Lavender  
Evergreen shrub 3-4 ft. high and wide with aromatic gray foliage and lavender summer flowers. Needs little water, sun, and well drained soils.
- ✓ **Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'** English Lavender  
Slow growing lavender to 1 ft. tall with deep purple flowers. Cutting grown so are uniform and true to form.
- ✓ **Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead'** English Lavender  
This dwarf lavender grows 1-2 ft. tall and has deep lavender flowers in spring and summer. Cutting grown so are uniform and true to form.
- ✓ **Lavandula stoechas** Spanish Lavender  
Dense shrub growing 2-3 ft. tall with blue-gray foliage and deep purple flowers that have large showy bracts near the top of the spikes.
- ✓ **Lavandula 'Otto Quast'**  
Thought to be a cross between *L. stoechas* and *L. dentata*. Grows 2' tall. Flower spikes topped with purple bracts that are showier than *L. stoechas*.
- ✓ **Leucophyllum frutescens** Texas Ranger  
Dense evergreen shrub from 5-12 ft. high and 3-5 ft. wide with gray foliage and purple flowers in summer. Tolerates wind, heat, and full sun.
- ✓ **Leucophyllum laevigatum** Texas Ranger  
Evergreen shrub with small, green foliage and purple summer flowers growing 3-5 ft. high.
- ✓ **Lilium pardalinum** Leopard Lily  
✦Vigorous perennial bulb that is hardy to 10°F. with smooth strap-shaped leaves and early summer flowers that are red and orange spotted with purple. The flower stalk can often reach 4-5 ft. high.
- ✓ **Lithodora diffusa 'Grace Ward'**  
Prostrate perennial from 6-12 in. tall with green hairy leaves and stems and bright blue flowers from May-July. Full sun to partial shade.

- ✓ **Lobelia laxiflora** Mexican Lobelia  
Showy semishrubby perennial growing to 2 ft. and spreading by underground rhizomes. Has bright tubular orange-red summer flowers, and tolerates low water conditions.
- ✓ **Lupinus albitrons** Bush Lupine  
Evergreen shrub to 5 ft. tall with soft silver-gray stems and foliage. Fragrant spring flowers are purple with white. Full sun and little to no water once established.
- ✓ **Mahonia aquifolium 'Compacta'** Dwarf Oregon Grape  
Evergreen shrub to 2 ft. tall with holly-like green and bronzy leaves, yellow flowers, and purple berries. Takes sun or shade and spreads from underground stems.
- ✓ **Mahonia pinnata 'Ken Hartman'**  
Large shrub to 12 ft. tall and 4-6 ft. wide with showy, crinkled foliage that has red-orange new growth. Tolerates sun or shade conditions.
- ✓ **Mahonia repens** Creeping Mahonia  
Evergreen shrub 1-3 ft. high with spiny red to green foliage and yellow spring flowers. Spreads by underground stems and is resistant to oak root fungus.
- ✓ **Maytenus boaria** Mayten Tree  
Slow growing evergreen tree reaching 30-40 ft. with long weeping branches and light green leaves. Give deep watering and good drainage.
- ✓ **Maytenus boaria 'Green Showers'** Mayten Tree  
Slow growing tree to 40 ft. with weeping branches of dark green leaves. Can sucker in lawns. Needs good drainage.
- ✓ **Moraea indidodes (Dietes bicolor)** Fortnight Lily  
Evergreen perennial with erect strap-shaped leaves to 2 ft. Pale yellow flowers are marked with maroon and bloom throughout the year.
- ✓ **Myoporum parvifolium 'Davis'**  
Prostrate ground cover staying 8-12 in. tall and 10-15 ft. wide with dense, light green, 1 in. long foliage. Good for slope stabilization.
- ✓ **Myrica californica** Pacific Wax Myrtle  
Evergreen shrub or tree to 25 ft. Tolerates sun or partial shade for inland areas.
- ✓ **Nandina domestica 'Compacta'** Dwarf Heavenly Bamboo  
Evergreen shrub reaching 4-5 ft. high with green and bronze foliage turning red in winter. Resistant to oak root fungus and hardy to 10°F.
- ✓ **Oenothera berlandieri 'Siskiyou'** Mexican Primrose  
Perennial staying 10-12 in. high with profuse pink flowers in summer. Spreads by underground rhizomes, drought tolerant and hardy to 10°F.
- ✓ **Oenothera stubbei** Baja Evening Primrose  
Perennial which creates a dense mat of green foliage and blooms yellow flowers in summer.
- ✓ **Penstemon 'Apple Blossom'** Border Penstemon  
Showy perennial 2-4 ft. high with light pink tubular blossoms on long flower spikes from spring through fall. Hardy to 15°F.
- ✓ **Penstemon 'Bev Jensen'** Border Penstemon  
Low light growing perennial to 20 in. high with large rosey-pink flowers in summer.
- ✓ **Penstemon 'Firebird'** Border Penstemon  
Perennial with bright red showy flower spikes.
- ✓ **Penstemon 'Midnight'** Border Penstemon  
Perennial with deep purple flower spikes.
- ✓ **Perovskia atriplicifolia** Russian Sage  
Winter dormant woody perennial to 3 ft. tall with toothed gray-green foliage and small lavender flowers in spikelike clusters that have an airy affect.
- Philadelphus lewisii** Wild Mock Orange  
Deciduous shrub growing 8-10 ft. with white fragrant flowers blooming June-July. Tolerates sun or partial shade.
- Philadelphus lewisii 'Goose Creek'**  
Showy shrub with arching trunks to 8 ft. with fragrant fully double white flowers in summer. Prefers sun and moist soils and is hardy to 0°F.
- ✓ **Pholinia fraseri**  
Large evergreen shrub 8-12 ft. high with glossy green leaves, red new growth and clusters of white flowers in spring. Tolerant of heat, smog, and wind.
- ✓ **Pinus ponderosa** Ponderosa Pine  
Large evergreen tree that can eventually reach 100 ft. or more. Grow in cool areas away from strong winds.
- ✓ **Pinus sabiniana** Gray Pine/Digger Pine  
Fast growing to 40-50 ft. high. Tolerates heat, smog, and drought conditions as well as moist conditions.
- ✓ **Pistacia chinensis** Chinese Pistache  
Deciduous tree growing 30-50 ft. high and wide with bright orange, red and yellow leaflets in fall. Tolerates heat, drought, smog and full sun. Resistant to oak root fungus.
- ✓ **Pittosporum tobira 'Wheeler's Dwarf'**  
Evergreen compact shrub staying 1-2 ft. high with glossy green leaves
- Platanus racemosa** California Sycamore  
Fast growing deciduous tree reaching 50-100 ft. Tolerant of heat, wind, moist soils.
- Populus fremontii** Fremont Cottonwood  
Fast growing deciduous trees reaching 40-60 ft. with bright yellow fall color. Does fine with little water or in flooded areas. Revegetation uses.
- Populus fremontii 'Nevada'** Male Fremont Cottonwood  
Saratoga Horticultural Foundation's introduction of this male variety cottonwood with glossy, deep green leaves turning yellow in fall. Also excellent for revegetation uses.
- ✓ **Prunus ilicifolia** Hollyleaf Cherry  
Evergreen shrub or tree from 20-40 ft. with dark green toothed foliage, white flowers and red fall berries.
- ✓ **Prunus lyonii** Catalina Cherry  
Evergreen shrub or tree from 15-40 ft. high and 20 ft. wide with showy white flowers in spring and cherry fruits in fall. Resistant to drought and oak root fungus.
- ✓ **Quercus agrifolia** Coast Live Oak  
Evergreen round-headed tree 30-60 ft. high and wide. Grows well from the coast to interior valleys.
- ✓ **Quercus chrysolepis** Canyon Live Oak  
Evergreen tree from 30-40 ft. Adaptable to many soil types. Moderate growth rate.
- ✓ **Quercus douglasii** Blue Oak  
Deciduous tree having slow growth to 30-50 ft. high with small 2' lobed blue-green leaves. Very drought tolerant.
- ✓ **Quercus dumosa** California Scrub Oak  
Evergreen, drought tolerant shrub growing 5-10 ft. with flaking bark.
- ✓ **Quercus kelloggii** California Black Oak  
Deciduous tree from 20-60 ft. high with sharply lobed leaves which turn yellow to orange in fall.
- ✓ **Quercus lobata** Valley Oak  
Large Deciduous tree from 60-80 ft. tall with a rounded canopy spreading 50-70 ft. wide with leaves deeply lobed and rounded. Very heat tolerant.
- ✓ **Quercus palustris** Pin Oak  
Fast growing deciduous tree from 50-80 ft., with pyramidal shape when young and rounded head at maturity. Glossy, deeply lobed leaves turn yellow to red in fall, often staying on tree through winter.
- ✓ **Quercus suber** Cork Oak  
Evergreen oak growing 70-100 ft. high with interesting corky bark. Toothed leaves are dark green above and gray beneath. Requires well drained soil and is a good street or park tree.
- ✓ **Quercus wisizenii** Interior Live Oak  
Evergreen tree from 30-70 ft. high forming a broad rounded crown. Can tolerate some shade. Good for parks and lawns.
- ✓ **Rhamnus alaternus** Italian Buckthorn  
Fast growing evergreen shrub from 10-20 ft. high and wide. Tolerates heat, drought, wind, and full sun or partial shade.
- ✓ **Rhamnus californica** Coffeeberry  
Evergreen shrub reaching 12-15 ft. high inland with large green to black berries April-June. Tolerates sun or partial shade in all soil types.
- ✓ **Rhamnus californica 'Eve Case'** Coffeeberry  
Dense compact shrub staying 3-8 ft. tall with equal spread. Large showy berries.
- ✓ **Rhamnus crocea ilicifolia** Holly-leaf Redberry  
Evergreen shrub or tree to 15 ft. high with holly-like leaves. Good for dry banks or screens. Very tolerant of full sun and drought.
- ✓ **Rhododendron macrophyllum** Coast Rhododendron  
Evergreen shrub to 4-10 ft. high with dark green, leathery leaves and rosey spring flowers.
- ✓ **Rhododendron occidentale** Western Azalea  
Deciduous shrub growing 6-10 ft. with showy fragrant white to pink flower clusters from May-June. Prefers shade and is hardy to -5°F.
- ✓ **Rhus integrifolia** Lemonade Berry  
Evergreen shrub to 30 ft. with aromatic leaves small white to pink flowers and red berries. Grows best in coastal areas and is tolerant of drought conditions.

- ✓ **Rhus laurina** Laurel Sumac  
 ♣Fast growing large evergreen shrub to 15 ft. high and wide with aromatic foliage, showy white summer flowers, and white winter fruit.
- ✓ **Rhus ovata** Sugar Bush  
 ♣Evergreen shrub from 8-15 ft. high with creamy flowers Mar-May and small red fruit. Good in inland areas.
- ✓ **Ribes aureum var. gracillimum** Golden Currant  
 ♣Deciduous shrub 4-8 ft. high and wide with yellow flowers turning reddish and orange or yellow berries Feb.-Mar. Takes full sun or shade.
- ✓ **Ribes sanguineum glutinosum** Flowering Currant  
 ♣Erect spreading deciduous shrub from 4-6 ft. tall with lobed toothed foliage, pink flowers, and black berries Jan.- Mar. Tolerates heat, drought, sun or shade.
- ✓ **Ribes sanguineum glutinosum 'Claremont'** Flowering Currant  
 ♣Deciduous shrub to 8 ft. tall and wide with an 8-10 in. long flower raceme blooming beautiful light pink flowers from Feb.-Mar.
- ✓ **Ribes sanguineum 'White Icicle'** Flowering Currant  
 A University of British Columbia Botanical Gardens registered introduction. Deciduous shrub growing 10 ft. high and 6 ft. wide with beautiful pure white flowers on 12 in. racemes in early spring. Tolerates sun or light shade.
- ✓ **Ribes vibumifolium** Evergreen Currant  
 ♣Evergreen shrub 3-6 ft. tall and 6-10 ft. wide with small rose-colored flowers and red berries from Feb.- April. Tolerates moist or dry conditions, sun, or inland shade.
- ✓ **Romneya coulteri** Matilija Poppy  
 ♣Perennial to 6 ft. tall with gray-green foliage and large showy white flowers with yellow stamens blooming May-July. Spreads by underground rhizomes. Needs full sun.
- ✓ **Rosa californica** California Wild Rose  
 ♣Shrub to 6 ft. with single pink flowers in clusters. Tolerates sun or shade and is hardy to 15°F.
- ✓ **Rosmarinus officinalis 'Ken Taylor'** Rosemary  
 Fragrant evergreen shrub growing to 2 ft. high and spreading to 4 ft. with nice trailing habit down banks or walls. Bright lavender blue flowers.
- ✓ **Rosmarinus officinalis 'Lockwood de Forest'** Rosemary  
 Trailing fragrant evergreen shrub to 3 ft. high with blue flowers throughout the year. Tolerates wind, smog, poor soils and drought. Resembles *R. Prostratus*.
- ✓ **Rosmarinus officinalis 'Majorica Pink'** Rosemary  
 Upright, fragrant evergreen shrub growing 4-5 ft. high and wide with soft pink flowers.
- ✓ **Rosmarinus officinalis 'Tuscan Blue'** Rosemary  
 Rigid upright shrub from 3-6 ft. high with dark green leaves and bright showy lavender-blue flowers throughout the year.
- ✓ **Rubus calycinoides 'Emerald Carpet'**  
 Dense, evergreen ground cover with interesting nearly round, crinkled dark green leaves and small white flowers. Good in rock garden.
- ✓ **Rubus vitifolius** California Blackberry  
 ♣Deciduous, mounding vine with large trifoliate leaves and small white spring flowers. Stems have small thorns. Found near waterways.
- ✓ **Salix goodingii** Black Willow  
 ♣Deciduous tree from 20-30 ft. with narrow light green leaves. Sun or partial shade.
- ✓ **Salix hindsiana** Sandbar Willow  
 ♣Deciduous shrub or tree 6-15 ft. high with gray silky leaves.
- ✓ **Salix laevigata** Red Willow  
 ♣Large deciduous tree 20-40 ft. tall found along streambanks
- ✓ **Salix lasiandra** Western Black Willow  
 ♣Deciduous tree growing 20-30 ft. high and 20 ft. wide. Large leaves smooth and green above, white and hairy beneath.
- ✓ **Salix lasiolepis** Arroyo Willow  
 ♣Deciduous shrub or tree 6-20 ft. high occurring along streambanks or in moist areas. Leaves smooth and green above and hairy below.
- ✓ **Salvia 'Allen Chickering'** Allen Chickering Sage  
 ♣Perennial shrub 2-5 ft. high and 2-4 ft. wide with fragrant gray foliage and blue flowers blooming spring and summer.
- ✓ **Salvia chamedroides**  
 Perennial shrub growing 2 ft. high with soft gray foliage and showy blue flower spikes spring through summer.
- ✓ **Salvia clevelandii** Cleveland Sage  
 ♣Perennial shrub growing 4 ft. high and wide with fragrant gray foliage and blue flowers May-August. Full sun and well drained soil preferred.
- ✓ **Salvia clevelandii 'Aromas'**  
 ♣A Saratoga Horticultural Foundation selection staying more compact than the species, growing to 3-4 ft., with distinctively fragrant gray-green foliage and violet flowers that flower into October.
- ✓ **Salvia clevelandii 'Whirley Blue'**  
 ♣A Saratoga Horticultural Foundation selection chosen for its many dark blue-violet whorled flower spikes and fragrant gray-green foliage. This sub-shrub grows 4-5 ft. high and up to 6 ft. wide, flowers bloom May-August, and it tolerates full sun, dry conditions, and cold to 20 degrees.
- ✓ **Salvia clevelandii 'Winifred Gillman'**  
 ♣Dense, compact sub-shrub staying 3 ft. high and wide, with a rounded form. Blue flowers in spikes above foliage spring-summer.
- ✓ **Salvia greggii** Autumn Sage  
 Hybrid Evergreen shrub 3-4 ft. high with fragrant green leaves and colorful flowers blooming spring through summer. Tolerates sun or partial shade. Hardy to 15°F. Flower colors: Coral, Pink, Purple, Red, White
- ✓ **Salvia leucantha** Mexican Sage  
 ♣Bushy shrub 3-4 ft. tall and wide with hairy white stems, gray-green leaves and velvet like purple flower spikes that bloom summer through fall. Tolerates sun, light shade, little water, and is hardy to 15°F.
- ✓ **Salvia leucophylla** Purple Sage  
 ♣Evergreen shrub growing 2-6 ft. with white tomentose stems and leaves and light purple flowers May-June. Tolerates heat and drought.
- ✓ **Salvia leucophylla 'Pl. Sal'** Dwarf Purple Sage  
 ♣Similar to *S. leucophylla* but only grows to 3-4 ft.
- ✓ **Salvia microphylla** Autumn Sage  
 Evergreen shrub growing to 6 ft. high with bright red flowers throughout the year.
- ✓ **Salvia mellifera** Black Sage  
 ♣Evergreen shrub growing 2-5 ft. tall with aromatic green foliage and pale blue flowers from April-May.
- ✓ **Salvia picturii**  
 Perennial growing 1-2 ft. high with long green foliage and bright blue flower spikes covering the shrub spring through fall.
- ✓ **Sambucus caerulea** Blue Elderberry  
 ♣Deciduous shrub from 4-10 ft. tall or a tree to 40 ft. high. Leaves have 5-9 leaflets with white spring flower clusters developing into blue berries.
- ✓ **Sambucus mexicana** Mexican Elderberry  
 ♣Deciduous shrub or tree similar to *S. caerulea* but leaves are paler green with 3-5 leaflets. Fast growing and drought tolerant plant.
- ✓ **Scaevola 'Mauve Clusters'**  
 Perennial ground cover staying 4-6 in. high and spreading to 3 ft. with glossy green foliage and lilac flowers that bloom April thru Nov. May freeze back in cold winters.
- ✓ **Schinus molle** California Pepper Tree  
 ♣Fast growing evergreen tree to 25-40 ft. tall and wide with branches that have a weeping habit. Has clusters of rose colored berries in fall.
- Sequoia sempervirens** Coast Redwood  
 ♣Evergreen tree growing 3-5 ft. a year, and able to reach 100-300 ft. high and 15-30 ft. wide. Good landscape tree. Seedlings vary greatly.
- Sequoia sempervirens 'Aptos Blue'** Coast Redwood  
 ♣Dense blue-green foliage with horizontal branches with branchlets which hang down.
- Sequoia sempervirens 'Los Altos'** Coast Redwood  
 ♣Dark green foliage on arching horizontal branches.
- Sequoia sempervirens 'Santa Cruz'** Coast Redwood  
 ♣Pendulous light green foliage.
- Sequoia sempervirens 'Soquel'** Coast Redwood  
 ♣Bluish green fine textured foliage with branchlets that slightly turn up at the end of the horizontal branches.
- Sequoiadendron giganteum** Giant Sequoia  
 ♣Huge evergreen trees reaching 80-300 ft. tall with dense gray-green foliage. Does best in deep soil with deep, infrequent waterings.
- ✓ **Sisyrinchium bellum 'Nana'** Dwarf Blue-Eyed Grass  
 ♣Perennial from 6-8 in. tall with blue-green blades of grass-like clumps with purple spring flowers. Needs shade.
- ✓ **Sisyrinchium californicum** Yellow-Eyed Grass  
 ♣Grass-like perennial to 16 in. tall with yellow spring flowers. Tolerates wet soils. Needs shade.
- ✓ **Sisyrinchium macounii 'Album'**  
 Grass-like perennial 12-16 in. tall with white spring flowers. Needs shade.

- ✓ *Trachelospermum asiaticum* Asian Jasmine  
Evergreen vine or ground cover spreading 10-15 ft. with creamy-yellow fragrant flowers from Apr.-Jun. Tolerates sun or partial shade.
- ✓ *Trachelospermum jasminoides* Star Jasmine  
Evergreen vine to 20 ft. or ground cover 1-2 ft. tall and 4-5 ft. wide with white fragrant flowers in summer. Takes sun or partial shade.
- ✓ *Trichostema lanatum* Woolly Blue Curls  
Evergreen shrub reaching 3-5 ft. high with open branching habit. Noted for its brilliant purple wooly flowers on long stalks in spring and summer.
- ✓ *Tulbaghia violacea 'Variegata'* Society Garlic  
Garlic scented perennial having green narrow leaves with white margins to 1 ft. tall and lavender flower clusters on a 1-2 ft. stem in spring and summer.
- ✓ *Umbellularia californica* California Bay  
Aromatic evergreen tree or large shrub slowly growing to 30-60 ft high. Tolerates sun or shade, moist or dry conditions.
- Viburnum davidii* David Viburnum  
Evergreen shrub staying 1-3 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide with glossy green leaves, white flowers and blue fruit. Does best in partial shade in acid soils.
- Viburnum plicatum 'Summer Snowflake'* Double-file Viburnum  
University of British Columbia Botanical Gardens registered introduction. Deciduous shrub reaching 6 ft. high and 4 ft. wide with white flowers spring through fall. Tolerates full sun to light shade.
- ✓ *Vitis californica* California Wild Grape  
Woody deciduous vine with round large leaves, small fragrant blooms and berry clusters in summer. Has sprawling, climbing growth habit.

- ✓ *Westringia rosmariniformis*  
Evergreen shrub from 3-6 ft. tall with soft gray-green leaves and white flowers throughout the year. Prefers sun and little to average water.
- ✓ *Zauschneria arizonica* Arizona Fuchsia  
Woody perennial to 2 ft. with upright, erect growth habit. Large scarlet flowers are set off by dark green foliage.
- ✓ *Zauschneria californica* California Fuchsia  
Showy perennial shrub growing 1-2 ft. high with upright stems gray-green foliage and bright orange-red tubular flowers. Attracts hummingbirds.
- ✓ *Zauschneria 'Everett's Choice' (c. latifolia)* Prostrate Fuchsia  
Showy perennial staying 6 in. high with fuzzy gray-green foliage and bright orange-red tubular flowers in spring and summer. Good for hot, dry areas. Attracts hummingbirds.

## California Native Grasses

- Deschampsia caespitosa holciformis* Tufted Hair Grass  
Clumping grass to 10 in. tall with spring flowers to 2 ft. Tolerates partial shade and heavy clay soils. Good in waterside plantings and meadows.
- ✓ *Elymus glaucus* Blue Wild Rye  
Upright perennial bunchgrass, 1-2 ft. tall with bluish blades and summer flowers. Tolerates drought, clay soils, and establishes rapidly.
- ✓ *Elymus triticoides* Creeping Wild Rye  
Upright green blades reach 2 ft. high with summer and fall inflorescences reaching 3 ft.
- ✓ *Festuca californica* California Fescue  
Blue-green bunchgrass with blades to 2 ft. and flower stalks to 5 ft. high, creating fountain-like clumps. Drought tolerant for sun or shade.
- ✓ *Festuca idahoensis* Idaho Fescue  
Densely tufted perennial grass usually blue in color but can be green. Flowering stalks to 1-2 ft. tall.
- Festuca rubra* Red Fescue  
Cool-season perennial growing 8-10 in. tall and spreads by rhizomes. Has fine texture and reddish color at the base of the leaves.
- ✓ *Muhlenbergia rigens* Deer Grass  
Perennial forming dense clumps from the base. Spikelike flower stalks 2-3 ft. tall. Striking fountain form.
- ✓ *Meilica imperfecta* Melic Grass  
Cool season grass growing 1-2 ft. with flower spikes tinged purple. Tolerates full sun or partial shade with moderate water.
- ✓ *Sitanion jubatum* Big Squirrel-Tail Grass  
Clumping grass with gray-green leaf blades and red-purple inflorescence in summer and fall. Tolerant of full sun and dry soils.
- ✓ *Stipa cernua* Nodding Stipa  
Spreading bunchgrass with thin, fine, leaf blades and graceful flower inflorescence in spring through summer.

- ✓ *Stipa lepida* Foothill Stipa  
Bunchgrass growing 1-2 ft. with graceful shiny flowers to 30 in. and blades that turn reddish gold through fall and winter.
- ✓ *Stipa pulchra* Purple Needle Grass  
Bunch grass growing 1-2 ft. high with graceful, shiny flower stalks to 30" in spring and summer. Fire retardant, tolerates drought, is good in mass plantings and restoration uses. California's State Grass.

## Ornamental Grasses

- Deschampsia 'German Hybrid'*  
Open, delicate evergreen clump to 1 ft. high with clean flower stems to 2 ft. Tolerates lots of water and shade.
- ✓ *Festuca amethystina 'Superba'* Rainbow Fescue  
Hardy fescue with fine blue green foliage to 8 in. with spring flowers to 12 in. above foliage. Very showy, neat grass for sunny spots spring-fall.
- Koeleria glauca* Blue Meadow Grass  
Evergreen bunch grass with blue-gray 4-6 in. high foliage with 1 ft. high spring flowers. Takes full sun, and is good for borders and rock gardens.
- ✓ *Miscanthus sinensis gracillimus* Maiden Grass  
Large, upright, clumping grass 4-6 ft. tall and wide with bronze spring flowers. Takes full sun and drought, and has beautiful orange fall color. Use as a screen, background plant or specimen.
- ✓ *Miscanthus sinensis 'Yaku Jima'* Dwarf Eulalia Grass  
Upright arching bunch grass to 3 ft. with dark green blades and a pink/white late summer flower on 4 ft. stalks. Nice reddish fall color.
- ✓ *Stipa tenuissima*  
Beautiful, fine, airy grass that is emerald green in color with many soft yellow/beige flower stalks in spring. Grows 10-12 in. tall and 1-2 ft. wide.

## Ferns

- Adiantum pedatum* Five-Finger Fern  
Airy, delicate fern to 1 ft. high for moist shady areas. Hardy to Sunset Zone 1.
- ✓ *Dryopteris erythrosora* Wood Fern  
Attractive, drought tolerant fern, 1-2 ft. tall with spreading habit for shade areas. Tolerant to Sunset Zone 1.
- Osmunda regalis* Royal Fern  
Large fern with rounded leaflets, known to reach 5-6 ft. in moist, shady conditions. Tolerates all Sunset Zones.
- Pellaea falcata* Cliff Brake Fern  
Small fern to 1 ft. with dark green fronds for shady, moist areas. Resprouts after frost.
- Polystichum munifolium* Sword Fern  
Common fern for moist, shady locations with leathery, dark green fronds 2-4 ft. high. Fronds good for cut arrangements.
- ✓ *Woodwardia fimbriata* Giant Chain Fern  
Large fern ultimately growing 4-8 ft. high. Can tolerate full sun but does best in some shade.
