

Asparagus spears





Dear Mr. Schulz:

The Sacramento River Delta Historical Society is in the process of identifying the historic sites and structures within our area. Roughly, along the Sacramento River from Freeport to Collinsville for several miles on both sides of the river. Near the river banks are sites of old landings and homes. Some of the homes are still standing. There are also trees and plants (Camellias) of historic significance. You are probably aware of Locke and the Isleton Chinatown. There is a family cemetery in Walnut Grove. Specific buildings include the "old bank building" in Courtland and the Jean Harvie Center in Walnut Grove. There are also indian mounds and school and cannery sites scattered along the river and sloughs.

We appreciate that you need more specific information and look forward to giving you some in the future. At the moment we are aware of Giusti's third generation restaurant located on Snodgrass Slough near the North Fork of the Mokelumne. You are probably aware that steamships at one time plied the Mokelumne as far as Wodbridge and briefly, even farther.
