

Dear Mr. Cheechov:

We are requesting a Farmland Conversion Impact Ratings for our Prospect Island Fish and Wildlife Habitat Restoration Project. Prospect Island is located in Solano County in the northwestern part of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. The island is bounded by the Sacramento River Deep Water Ship Channel to the east, the remnants of Little Holland Tract to the north, Miner Slough to the east, and the confluence of the ship channel and Miner Slough to the south (enclosure 1). The island is surrounded by levees. The project area encompasses 1,316-acres on the northern portion of the island. This land has been used in the past for agricultural purposes and would be affected through implementation of the project.

A copy of a 7.5-minute quadrangle map with the site location is enclosed (enclosure 2) as well as the Farmland Conversion Impact Rating form (enclosure 3).




