Dear Colonel Le Cuyer:

This letter is in regard to the Sacramento River Flood Control System Evaluation studies and, more specifically, to a portion of the Mid-Valley area, Phase III.

Meetings between members of our respective staff have determined that more effective planning could occur by moving Cache Creek, Willow Slough and Putah Creek from the Mid-Valley Area Study (Phase III) into the Lower Sacramento Area Study (Phase IV). In this way, the Phase IV Study would have the advantage of evaluating the three streams which will also be evaluated in the Yolo Bypass Reconnaissance Study. The two studies are presently scheduled to occur concurrently. We believe this change would eliminate some duplication of effort. Therefore, we respectfully request that the evaluation of the three tributaries be redirected as described above.
