

Message: Storage and Conveyance Components

Dave:

Rich Golb and I are looking to develop a simplified matrix or series of tables which would provide a quick overview of possible combinations of storage and conveyance (north of delta, south of delta, in-delta, if applicable) and their impacts relative to export water quality (TDS, Bromide, TOC levels at export pumps), fishery enhancement benefits (these "benefits" may simply be the operational criteria employed in your analysis), and water supply. For each combination, we would like to also show associated capital and annual costs and assumptions used in the analysis.

If you can get us summary information of this type, we can arrange it in a format that works for us.

Also, has CALFED performed an analysis which seeks to determine the size of the isolated facility is required to allow the fish requirements desired by the state and federal regulatory agency biologists to be attained and increase the current CVP and SWP water supplies and reliability? If so, could we obtain the results of this analysis?
