Subject : Status Report on the Proposition 204 Potential Off-Stream Storage Facilities Special Status Species Surveys

The Department of Fish and Game (DFG) has been contracted by the Department of Water Resources to conduct field investigations for the presence of fish, amphibian, reptile, and mammal species that are State or Federally listed as Threatened, Endangered, or Special Concern.

The DFG has recently completed their revisions on the August 1998 Draft Status Report which is attached for circulation. This report provides results and discussions of the first year of studies. The final report will be submitted discussing the results of threatened, endangered, and special status species on the four proposed reservoirs upon the completion of the remaining year of studies, estimated to be June 30, 1999.
