Subject: Draft Language in Response to Babbitt/Dunn Briefing

Attached is a revision of the document you received yesterday. This version includes points raised in Tom's summary of the meeting, specifically:

- discussion of interim water quality "benchmarks" to accompany the concept of continuous improvement.
- need to enforce existing water quality regulations
- continuous improvement needs to be measured in the Solution Area, not just Delta
- more explicit linkage of watershed and water quality programs
- a discussion of the implications of the water quality implications of catastrophic levee failure.

No attempt has yet been made to put these inclusions into the draft document, pending a decision on the suitability of the contents and identification of the locations in the document where the language should appear. This can be accomplished quickly, however, when these decisions are made.

Nothing has yet been done to the example on bromide/TOC because my notes clearly indicate that Lester said it should be included. This will have to be resolved.

I will be available today between 10:00 and 12:00, and from 14:00 to 16:30 hours this afternoon to discuss the document. Steve indicated we had until the end of today to produce a revised document. Does that mean the same thing as first thing Monday morning?
