

**SUMMARY OF AGRICULTURAL LAND AND SEASONAL WETLAND HABITAT
TARGET ADDITIONS INCLUDED IN THE REVISED ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION
PROGRAM PLAN (MARCH 1998 DRAFT)**

Colusa Basin	Seasonal Wetland	Protect and manage 2,000 acres of existing seasonal wetland habitat. ^{1/}
Colusa Basin	Seasonal Wetland	Develop and implement a cooperative program to improve management of 26,435 acres of existing, degraded wetland habitat. ^{1/}

Butte Basin	Seasonal Wetland	Assist in protecting 10,000 acres of existing seasonal wetland habitat through fee acquisition or perpetual easements. ^{1/}

San Joaquin River	Seasonal Wetland	Assist in protecting 52,500 acres of existing seasonal wetland habitat through fee acquisition or perpetual easements. ^{1/}
San Joaquin River	Seasonal Wetland	Develop and implement a cooperative program to enhance 120,300 acres of existing public and private seasonal wetland habitat. ^{1/}
San Joaquin River	Agricultural Land	Cooperatively enhance 15,290 acres of private agricultural lands to support nesting and wintering waterfowl. ^{1/}

These targets are provided by the Central Valley Habitat Joint Venture and are included in the Central Valley Habitat Joint Venture Implementation Plan, a component of the North American Waterfowl Management Plan. February 1990. These targets are consistent with the Ecosystem Restoration Program Plan and are included as additions to the March 1998 version of the ERPP. These targets do not involve any changes in basic land use other than deferring fall tillage, leaving waste grain for waterfowl forage, or other "wildlife friendly" agricultural practices.

Priorities have not been established for implementing ERPP habitat restoration actions. Implementation of these targets will be vested primarily in the Central Valley Habitat Joint Venture. CALFED will likely provide some funding to implement these targets, but the priority will probably be in the low to moderate range as other high priority actions need to be addressed prior to funding these targets.
