

SUBJECT: Example Workshop Scenario

The following is the example scenario developed for each Team Leader presentations at the **APPROACH TO IMPACT ANALYSIS WORKSHOP**. Keep in mind that this example is meant to represent a generic action(s) which could be taken by CALFED as part of one or more of its alternatives. The two examples chosen are 1.) setback levee, and 2.) re-operation. These were chosen because together they should encompass all resource categories to be discussed at the workshop.

DELTA COMPLETE LEVEE SETBACK:

- ◆ A new setback levee would be constructed
- ◆ Inland 60 to 250 feet from the existing levee
- ◆ Existing levee would be left in-place
- ◆ Fill used in construction could be commercial fill or dredged material
- ◆ Waterside slope would be armored with riprap
