

# Meeting Minutes

## Water Quality Impact Assessment Team

The meeting began with a general discussion of the Draft EIR/EIS and whether it will contain a preferred alternative when it is released to the public. Time constraints associated with the August release date may make this unfeasible.

Francis briefly talked about a dye study for bromide that is being undertaken. Models runs from this study will be available June 25. A previous run was completed March 22.

It was requested that the team be aware of the activities of other groups - particularly Fisheries and M&I Economics. Work of these groups should be briefly discussed and referenced in the Water Quality Technical Report.

Tom Brownie is writing up the 1976-1992 hydrological conditions.

There is a modeling meeting scheduled for May 2. Specific requests for water quality modeling will be needed at this time. The Fisheries team stated they will be using the other Teams' May 30, documents to focus their efforts.

The CALFED review team will review the documents and return comments in one week. All groups are to provide five hard copies and one electronic version of their reports.

The Draft Water Quality Affected Environment and Impact Assessment documents will be sent to the Water Quality Impact Assessment Team immediately after submittal to CALFED. Comments by the Team on these documents are to be submitted to Carol Howe by June 6, 1997.

The next Team meeting is scheduled for June 11, 1997.
