

CALFED Water Quality Program Potential Parameters of Concern¹

^aChromium VI was presented for consideration to the Parameter Assessment Team on December 3, 1997, by G. Fred Lee (G. Fred Lee & Associates). The listing of chromium VI as a potential parameter of concern was presented to the Water Quality Technical Group on December 3, 1997. No objections were noted.

^bMTBE was presented for consideration to the Parameter Assessment Team on January 28, 1998, by Inge Werner (Sierra Club). The listing of MTBE as a potential parameter of concern was presented to the Water Quality Technical Group on February 25, 1998. No objections were noted.

¹ The Parameter Assessment Team developed this Potential Parameters of Concern category for parameters where there is enough information to indicate a potential concern. Placement in this category means that there is not enough scientific information to justify a recommendation that a parameter be formally added to the parameter of concern list yet there is enough information to warrant that the parameter be tracked periodically for future development of needed information. A parameter on the potential parameter of concern list is not a candidate for a water quality implementation action.
