***CANCELLATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY  
CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SACRAMENTO RIVER AND SAN JOAQUIN RIVER  
BASINS***

On 22 October 1996 you received a notice stating that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Board) would consider a proposed amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan) for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins during a Board Meeting on 6 December 1996. The proposed amendment would have added wastewater generated from municipal, industrial and wetland management activities that is high in salt and unfit for reuse to the list of waters that should be conveyed from the San Joaquin and Tulare Basins to the Board's existing *Policy for Obtaining Salt Balance in the San Joaquin Valley*.

This agenda item has been canceled and will not be considered at the 6 December meeting. Staff received significant comments on the proposed amendment and, at this point, does not plan to pursue the amendment.
