Please pardon the lengthy delay in getting this information to you. I was in Waterloo, Canada last week and I had some work to do on the survey summaries when I returned. I hope that this is what you were looking for. Please let me know if there is something else you are looking for.

Enclosed are two summary data sheets. The first is the logging summary data from the first 6 sites – Boulder, Denver, Eugene, Seattle, San Diego, and Tampa. Information included on the logging summary:

- the percentage breakdown of indoor and outdoor usage and the breakdown of indoor use into various components
- average daily use per account
- gallons per capita per day

The second summary data sheets comprise the mail survey summary for all 12 logging sites. The mail survey was 12 pages long and had many questions. If you would like a copy of the actual survey, John Nelson probably has a few he would be willing to part with. What is presented here is simply the summarized results of the survey for each city.
