>I don't see an issue regarding spring-run numbers. I realized there were
>inconsistent/contradictory recovery/restoration numbers for all anadromous
>fish species. The ERP still champions maintaining average cohort
>replacement rates above 1.0 while the stock is rebuilding, and then to
>maintain a replacement rate equal to or greater than 1.0 when the stock
>reaches restoration goal levels set by the regulatory agencies.
