UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION
PETITION FOR TEMPORARY URGENCY CHANGE
IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND REDIVERSION
(Water Code 1435)

This petition is being submitted to facilitate the proposed action as detailed below.

The United States Bureau of Reclamation is filing under Water Code §1435, for a Temporary Urgency Change to add the State Water Project, Harvey O. Banks Pumping Plant as an additional point of diversion and rediversion under the Permit 12712 et al., issued on Application 5626 et al., as listed below:

Proposed Action

This petition is being filed to facilitate the diversion to and the storage of Central Valley Project (CVP) water in the Federal share of San Luis Reservoir and bring the Reservoir to full capacity during the period of February through March of 2000. Approval of this petition will allow CVP water under Reclamation Applications 5626 et al. to be directly diverted or rediverted from storage releases at the SWP Banks Pumping Plant and delivered through the SWP facilities to O'Neil Forebay and thence to San Luis Reservoir.

Reclamation proposes to accomplish this through use of SWP Banks in February and March of 2000. The SWP would otherwise use this capacity at Banks to move water into the unused space in Federal San Luis Reservoir; however, the SWP will make this capacity available to Reclamation and Reclamation will fill the Federal share of San Luis Reservoir during the period noted.
