Although Jersey is showing signs of improvement, the remaining stations continue to exceed the profile values. It is unlikely we will achieve the objective water quality conditions without additional actions including opening the Delta Cross Channel Gates.

This report contains data for the past thirty days which shows the increases in salinity since the Delta Cross Channel Gates closure on November 26, 1999.
