In response to Rick's observation that CALFED agencies have been reluctant to enforce water use efficiency, Jerry Johns clarified that the State Board is more comfortable with an adjudicatory role (resolving conflicting claims). Thus, Jerry felt that CALFED's implementation design could rely on the SWRCB to continue its adjudicatory role. Some proposals would have the SWRCB be both the "watch dog" evaluating conservation efforts and the "judge" ruling if such efforts were sufficient. The SWRCB has more traditionally been placed in the "judge" role with other parties bringing conflicting claims to it for resolution (e.g., IID was the outgrowth of a complaint).
