Water Resources and Delta Restoration Act of 1996
(as amended January 25, 1996)

- I. Legislative Findings - set goals to the year 2020
- II. Delta Restoration Program
 - A. State match required under the CVPIA (Miller-Bradley)
 - B. State share of Category III projects called for in the December, 1994 Bay/Delta Accord
 - C. To continue state funding for the Delta levee subvention program (Boatwright program)
 - D. To pay the mitigation costs of the South Delta barriers project
- III. Clean Water and Water Recycling Program (SWRCB)
 - A. State Revolving Fund (to meet federal Clean Water Act requirements/\$1 of state funds leverages \$5 federal)
 - B. Clean Water Grants to Small Communities (to meet federal Clean Water Act requirements)
 - C. Loans to water suppliers for water recycling projects
 - D. Loans to water suppliers for onsite drainage treatment and management projects
- IV. Water Resources Program
 - A. Feasibility investigations
 - Off-stream storage
 - Conjunctive Use
 - Water Recycling
 - Watershed Management
 - B. San Joaquin Valley Drainage Relief program to retire lands with severe drainage problems (Hill program)
 - C. Loans for water conservation and groundwater recharge projects
- V. Trigger mechanism - Expenditure of bond funds phased to coincide with completion of stages of CALFED process (1/3 available immediately, 1/3 upon completion of EIR/EIS, 1/3 upon obtaining permit for long-term Delta solution)
