Subject: Core Actions

The attached draft document entitled "Potential CALFED Core Actions" defines the core actions, proposes criteria used to identify them, and describes potential core actions identified to date. A major suggestion from participants at CALFED Workshop #4 held on December 4, 1995, was that the CALFED Bay-Delta Program should distinguish a set of core actions that could be common to all alternatives. To implement that suggestion, we have developed the attached preliminary set of core actions.

The core actions were originally included on the overall list of solution actions that were presented at Workshop #4. The core actions are now differentiated by the proposed criteria and by specified level of implementation. In general, core actions must have broad acceptance among all stakeholder groups at the core action level of implementation, provide measurable contributions to one or more Program objectives, and are cost-effective for implementation in combination with other core actions.
