Subject: Component Integration Example and Linkages

At the upcoming meeting, we will make a presentation outlining the component integration process and showing how components can be integrated into an example alternative. We will attempt to demonstrate the linkages among the various components and show how solution principles can be met when components are linked.

The attached Problem and Objective Statements for the Program components have been revised from earlier versions that were distributed. If you recall, we used these problem and objective statements early in Phase I when we were trying to develop synergistic actions that met the objectives of several Program components. We have added a section on Phase II Alternatives to give specific examples of how actions would benefit other resource areas. These Problem and Objective Statements are provided to assist you in understanding the example alternative that we will discuss at the upcoming meeting. The objective of this agenda item will be to provide BDAC members information on the integration process to help understand how the common and variable programs will be integrated.
