Dear Lester:

It would be helpful in our discussion on <sup>Jan. 29</sup> ~~December 12~~ if the material presented includes answers to the following questions.

- 1) For each alternative, including the common pool program, how will the plan affect the overall available central valley water supply when there is no "excess" outflow? The total supply for all purposes is limited in seasons and years when all available water is used for consumption in the valley, and for export from the valley, and to meet the Delta outflow required by the SWRCB's Delta Control Plan or by the Cal Fed plan.
- 2) What reallocations of this limited available supply would occur among urban, environmental, and agricultural uses under each alternative, including the effect of anticipated water transfers and changes in land use? How much of this reallocation will result from transfers?
- 3) What effect, if any, will each alternative plan have on the ability of the river systems and Delta channels to handle major flood flows, with particular regard to Mokelumne and south-eastern Delta channels, and flows along the San Joaquin valley floor?
