BDAC members and other interested people are invited to a tour of progressive irrigation and water management projects and techniques in Kern County on Wednesday, March 24, 1999, hosted by the Arvin-Edison Water Storage District, Kern Water Bank Authority and Kern County Water Agencies. A bus will leave the Holiday Inn Select in downtown Bakersfield at 12:00 noon to take BDAC members to the first stop on the tour. Lunch will be provided to BDAC members prior to the beginning of the tour.

Members of the public are also invited to the tour, but must provide their own transportation. The tour will begin at 1:30 at the Arvin-Edison Headquarters located at 20401 Bear Mountain Boulevard, Arvin. A map to the rendezvous point is attached. The headquarters are approximately 30 minutes from downtown Bakersfield.

We will visit the Arvin-Edison and Kern Water Bank areas to view innovative irrigation and established conjunctive use techniques. The Kern Water Bank also encompasses habitat conservation areas.
