- **Hood Diversion Discussion**

This is a follow-up item from the June 2, 2000 Hood Diversion presentation. The Work Group is asked to review the Fisheries Study Plan and begin discussions on developing a drinking water study plan for integration into the process. Two documents have been provided entitled: "Assessment of Delta Cross Channel Operations and a Sacramento River Diversion at Hood" and "Bay Delta Modeling Forum: Scenario 4 (Optimization of DCC Timing)" (sent as an e-mail attachment June 13, 2000).

- **Recommendations to the DDWC**

This is a carryover item from the June 2, 2000 DWCWG meeting. At the June 28, 2000 DDWC meeting, the Work Group is asked to: 1) Update the DDWC on the status and funding of the "Assessment of Sources and Magnitudes of Loads" Work Plan; 2) Make recommendations on the drinking water improvement projects as related to the Drinking Water Improvement Strategy and the Framework for Action; and, 3) Make recommendations with regard to a drinking water study plan to monitor drinking water improvements as a result of the Delta Cross Channel operations and a Sacramento River diversion at Hood.
