The next Ecosystem Roundtable meeting is scheduled for January 21 from 9:30 to 1:30 in Room 1412 of the Resources Building in Sacramento. This package includes a revised agenda, a redraft of the Implementation Strategy, and a meeting summary from our December meeting. The package also includes a list of the projects approved by the Category III Steering Committee in November 1996 as an informational item for Roundtable members and interested parties.

The Implementation Strategy was revised based on the discussions at the last Roundtable meeting as well as input from a number of technical experts. We are circulating the redraft to agency and stakeholder technical representatives to solicit their input. Any issues they raise will be brought to the Roundtable meeting for your consideration.

The first technical team meeting focused on the San Joaquin River and its tributaries will be held on January 15 and 16th. We will provide Roundtable members with an update on the San Joaquin meeting as well as on future technical team meetings for the Sacramento River and its tributaries, the Delta, the North Bay, and the American River. We would ask that you bring any nominations you might have for these technical teams to our January meeting or provide them to us by January 28.
