II. OUTSTANDING ISSUES

A. *Programmatic Peer Review* We need further discussion on whether, and to what extent, a more programmatic peer review of key foundational documents (i.e., documents that will be utilized as a basis for guiding ecosystem restoration investments, including the CALFED Ecosystem Restoration Program Plan, the CVPIA Anadromous Fish Restoration Plan, etc.) is needed and/or provided for in other contexts.

B. *Stakeholder Input* We need to discuss and resolve the role that stakeholder representatives (both policy and technical) will play in the ongoing development of various work products prior to formal Roundtable consideration.

C. *Outside Experts* At various points throughout this document, the need for assistance from "outside experts" (e.g., consultants, private non-profit trust or management organizations, university scientists, etc.) is identified. Additional work is needed to clarify what, exactly, is needed in each such instance, who might be eligible and/or best qualified, etc.

D. *Other* In the course of developing this document, it has become apparent that various evolving issues are likely to need attention from time to time which have not been thought through to date. These include, for example, potential interim "trust" services (e.g., interim ownership of acquired land and/or water resources), appropriate reserve fund policies, dealing with unsolicited proposals, etc.
