Thank you for reserving funding from the CALFED grant application 99-B131 as a tool to encourage flood control and watershed related discussions to occur between the major stakeholders in the Yuba-Feather River Watersheds.


Your actions have prompted two meetings (May 12, 2000 and June 27, 2000) regarding flood control and watershed issues. Both parties have contributed significant financial resources to these meetings in terms of time and consultants and plan to continue to do so with your help. Our next meeting is scheduled for July 25, 2000.

We request that \$30,000 dollars be made available to support continuing this process. This money would be used to fund a facilitated process to develop a formal proposal identifying actions to address flood control and watershed related issues. We request that you reserve the remaining \$186,150 from the grant application 99-B131 for pursuing these future actions. One of the first actions of the future meeting will be to rename the proposal to reflect our new start.

We appreciate your encouragement in this area and look forward to your future financial support.
