**Outcomes/Actions from September 7 and September 14 Small Group Meetings requiring follow-up**

**WMDT/EWA**

Ron Ott will send out letters of invitation to the newly-named Water Management Development Team (9/14).

**2000 Ops**

Steve Hirsch and Curtis Creel have developed a list of recommended actions to address filling San Luis Reservoir and averting a spring Delta smelt crisis. They will follow up with contacts to water users regarding potential storage availability and cost (9/14).

CALFED will take the lead on identifying sources of funds (9/7).

**Stage I/FY 2000 Priorities**

Steve Ritchie asked for agency feedback on draft document (9/7).

Lester proposed a follow-up meeting, with focus on cost shares for non-eco money (9/7).

**South Delta**

Project purposes language will be re-worked by DOI (9/7).

Re-circulation study will be reviewed by DWR before Small Group action (9/7).

**Water Management Strategy Work Plan**

Steve Ritchie requested agency red flag review by Wednesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, in order for document to be re-worked for BDAC on September 17<sup>th</sup> (9/14).

**Miscellaneous**

Steve Macaulay committed that DWR would follow up with the MWD on comment made at public hearing in Los Angeles that MWD needs only 650 TAF out of the Delta in a dry year (9/7).
