

Draft Outcomes
11-2-99 Water Management Development Team Meeting

1. The WMDT agreed to hold the next meeting on November 16 (and not hold a meeting on November 9).
2. Tom Zuckerman will suggest a different storage capacity assumption for evaluation of an in-Delta storage asset, and will provide this to Ron Ott at CALFED.
3. The Coordination Team was asked to do the following:
 - a. Provide a list of fishery actions used or proposed to be used for gaming, along with the biological concerns these actions are intended to address.
 - b. Make every attempt to provide qualitative conclusions of the various studies, along with appropriate technical results and identified concerns with the results.
 - c. Schedule and conduct a workshop on the daily vs. DWRSIM models. WMDT participants will be invited.
 - d. Continue to evaluate study results and evaluate the reasons for and meaning of different water supply and other impacts resulting from the daily model compared to the monthly (DWRSIM) time-step model.
 - e. Evaluate technical issues raised by the WMDT regarding appropriate application of the DOI B2 plan.
 - f. Break out export impacts from studies into separate SWP and CVP impacts.
 - g. Provide a more complete description of water demand assumptions.
4. CALFED staff will distribute by next week a comprehensive draft list of assets and their attributes, and ask for input from WMDT participants.
