

Draft Common Response Review

Attached are draft Common Responses #1, About the CALFED Bay-Delta program and the Programmatic Nature of the Document; #7, Keep Rivers Wild; #10, Bulletin 160 Numbers are Inappropriate for Use in Your Analysis; #21, Non-Structural Solutions; and #22, Will CALFED Solve California's Water Problems?

The common responses address general comments made on the PEIS/EIR and appendices. In general, existing language from the PEIS/EIR, Revised Phase II Report, Program Plans and other PEIS/EIR appendices was used to develop the common response. Therefore, if you take issue with a draft common response, it probably will require subsequent review and adjustment of a Program Plan, the PEIS/EIR or other CALFED document.

The common responses are structured with an introduction summarizing the comments addressed in the common response. Information that addresses the general comment, or a recurring theme of the overall topic of the Common Response, is then presented to provide a response. The reader is then directed to sources within the PEIS/EIR, Program Plans or other appendices for additional information.
