The CALFED Bay-Delta Program is bringing Californians together to find a long-term solution to problems in San Francisco Bay/Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta (the Bay-Delta). The Bay-Delta provides drinking water for two-thirds of the state and irrigates 4 million acres of farmland. Equally important, it is the west coast's largest estuary, rich in unique natural resources. If you are a Californian with a job, a kitchen sink, a cotton field, or an affection for the outdoors, chances are the Bay-Delta plays a big part in your life, even if you've never been within 100 miles of it.

The CALFED Bay-Delta Program has developed several alternative solutions to the many, complex problems plaguing the Bay-Delta.
