MILESTONE LOOMS ON BAY-DELTA SOLUTION

WHAT:

The CALFED Bay-Delta Program is nearing a major milestone in its historic effort to address the environmental and water management problems associated with the Bay-Delta system. At the first of the year, CALFED will release its draft preferred alternative for a Bay-Delta solution. On November 6, the Program will host an open house public meeting at the Commonwealth Club in San Francisco to gain input from Bay area communities.

WHY:

The decisions made over the next few months will impact every Californian. Communities in the Bay area have specific concerns, including:

- How will the Bay area's water supply and water quality be affected by upcoming decisions about the management of the Bay-Delta system?
- What is being done to improve the Bay-Delta ecosystem?
- What will the impact be to San Francisco Bay?
- How can local residents express their ideas and concerns to Bay-Delta policy makers?
