MILESTONE LOOMS ON BAY-DELTA SOLUTION

WHAT:

The CALFED Bay-Delta Program is nearing a major milestone in its historic effort to address the environmental and water management problems associated with the Bay-Delta system. At the first of the year, CALFED will release its draft preferred alternative for a Bay-Delta solution. On December 4, the Program will host an open house public meeting at the Vacation Inn in San Diego to gain input from local residents.

WHY:

The decisions made over the next few months will impact every Californian. San Diegans have specific concerns, including:

- What will be the impact on local water quality?
- How will the area's water supply reliability be affected by upcoming decisions about the management of the Bay-Delta system?
- How does the State Water Project, of which the Bay-Delta is the hub, fit in with San Diego's overall water supply plan?
- How can local residents express their ideas and concerns to Bay-Delta policy makers?
