MILESTONE LOOMS ON BAY-DELTA SOLUTION

WHAT:

The CALFED Bay-Delta Program is nearing a major milestone in its historic effort to address the environmental and water management problems associated with the Bay-Delta system. At the first of the year, CALFED will release its draft preferred alternative for a Bay-Delta solution. On December 9, the Program will host an open house public meeting in the Chico area to gain input from Northern Californians.

WHY:

The decisions made over the next few months will impact every Californian. Communities in Northern California have specific concerns, including:

- How will Northern California communities be affected by upcoming decisions about the management of the Bay-Delta system?
- What kinds of assurances will there be about the ability to continue to meet the water needs of Northerners?
- How are Delta watershed issues being addressed?
- How can local residents express their ideas and concerns to Bay-Delta policy makers?
