Dear John:

Thank you for your March 9 faxed update on the CALFED process.

I would appreciate a clarification of the relationship to the Advisory Council of the proposed Stakeholders group. That group name is apparently a new name for the CUA-Ag group. A prominent member of that group stated in a recent meeting that it was anticipated that all other entities would sit back and look to that group to decide what to do. It is misleading to liken that group to the three-way process. Their input to the CALFED agreement was made without any representation from either the Delta or the areas of origin, even though those areas will be heavily impacted by the agreement.

Is the Advisory Council expected to be the primary analyzer of potential Delta solutions, or is it merely expected to comment on proposals selected by the Stakeholders group and/or by government agencies?
