You have already seen a draft version of the "Programs Related to Improving and Protecting the Bay-Delta System," but look over the Introduction section to get an understanding of the relationship between these actions and the CALFED Bay-Delta Program.

You have also seen an earlier version of the "Problem/Objective Definition" package. This latest version is being circulated to further clarify the definitions for CALFED Agency members leading to adoption by CALFED. You may want to look over the "Water Supply Reliability" section.

The last document contains the latest discussion of potential core items for **each** alternative. Reclamation should pay particular attention to core items listed under "Reductions in the Effects of Diversions," "Reduction in Export Reliance" and "Increasing Water Supply Predictability."
