Dear Mr. Lang:

This is in reference to Task Order No. 2 dated November 14, 1995 of the Department of Water Resources Contract No. B-59818. In our letter dated January 2, 1996, we authorized completion of Task Item 1 up to a maximum amount of \$32,494. However, we did not increase the initial authorization of \$150,000 for Task Item 2.

Please consider this letter your authorization to proceed with continuing the consulting services for Task Item 2 up to, and not to exceed \$230,000, without further authorization in accordance with the attached revised estimate dated March 22, 1996 provided by you. This authorization increases the maximum total payable for Task Order No. 2 under the DWR contract B-59818 to \$262,494 without further authorization.

The assistance to CALFED Bay-Delta Program staff in **development** of BDAC materials and workshop materials as well as support for Program workshops specified in the Task Item is to be closely coordinated with support to be provided by the California Center for Public Dispute Resolution.
