Re: Ecosystem Restoration Program Plan, Volume 11: Ecological Zone Visions


This letter is to formally request an extension of time for comment on the CalFed document "Ecosystem Restoration Program Plan, Volume 11: Ecological Zone Visions." I understand that this is the document that deals with the "vision" plan for Yolo County and the North Delta. The District requests a 90 day extension of time for the comment period at the minimum. The District has never received a copy of this "vision" document which we hear is large and complex. Could we, also, have a copy of the document?

Facilities owned and operated by Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District are discussed in the "vision" plan, as well as Cache Creek, Putah Creek, and other matters dealing with both surface and groundwater in Yolo County. Since Yolo is a water deficient county, the Board of Directors of this District is very interested in any plans, documents, or environmental assessments dealing with water being transferred out of this county. All of the cities in Yolo except for West Sacramento are totally reliant on groundwater.

Again, I request at least a 90 day extension of the comment period on the above referenced CalFed document and a copy of the document.
